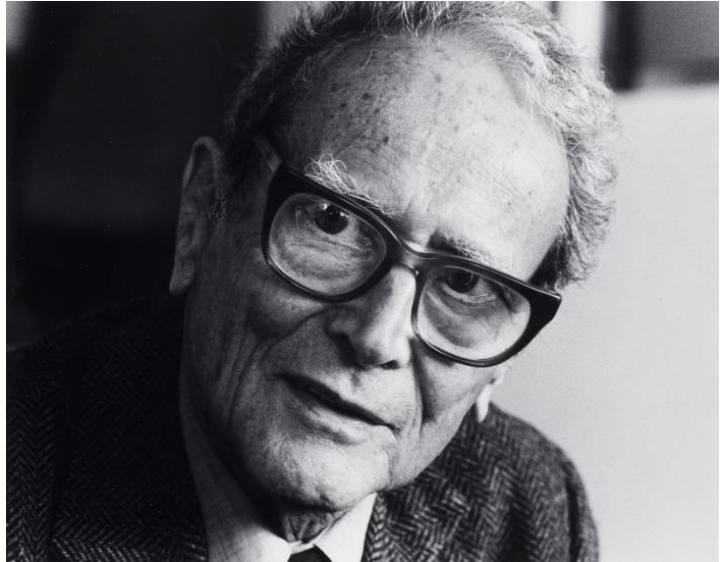


**#45 Dec. 2019 Cameraderie
Andreas Feininger (1906-1999)**



Andreas Feininger graduated from the famous Bauhaus art school as a cabinetmaker, where his father was Master of the Printing Workshop. Later, Feininger studied architecture, and eventually photography. His cityscape photography shows evidence of his training in architecture.
