
#45 Dec. 2019 Cameraderie Andreas Feininger (1906-1999)





Here are a few of his most notable photographs. I cannot find dates for most of them.






Feininger shot photographer Dennis Stock for Life Magazine. This iconic shot is one of his best-known photos.
